SCHOOL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

STUDENT AWARDS SYSTEM

This system aims to recognise individual student achievement. The system is cumulative and will carry across from year to year. It is the student's responsibility to keep track of **merit and achievement awards**. The school keeps a database on all awards from the Accomplishment Award level upwards.
